AMEND THE EL PASO COUNTY SPECIAL DISTRICT POLICIES TO UPDATE
THE TITLE 32 SPECIAL DISTRICTS ANNUAL REPORT FORM

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Colorado grants certain authority to El Paso County concerning the creation and operation of Special Districts and Local Improvement Districts within its boundaries pursuant to C.R.S. 30-20-501, et. seq. and C.R.S 32-1-101 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 32-1-207 (3)(c) specifically authorizes the County to require Title 32 Special Districts to file an annual report with the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners most recently adapted a form for annual report filing in 1990 as established in Resolution 90-139, General-53; and

WHEREAS, the County now desires to update this annual report form and expand it to provide a means of consistent communication and disclosure information to County residents and property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, hereby adopts this amended Annual Report and Disclosure form, attached as Exhibit A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all Title 32 Special Districts with territory wholly or partially included within the County's unincorporated area shall be required to complete the attached form on or before February 28, 2007, and by the same date each year thereafter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Development Services Department or other department as may be delegated by the County Administrator to maintain instructions for completing this form; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that County departments and Elected Officials are encouraged to make this district summary and disclosure information available on the County website and by other means; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that failure to file this annual report may result in the Board of County Commissioners providing authorization to the County Treasurer pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes 32-1-209 to prohibit release of funds due to the district until the district complies with their report requirements.

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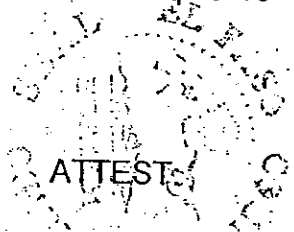
